

Adobe Licence Scheme

What is the scheme?

LT Scotland has signed an agreement with Adobe to make available to Scottish education Adobe products at the lowest possible price with no commitment to quantity.

How does the scheme work?

When an educational institution purchases an Adobe product for the first time, it must in the first instance purchase a licence and a copy of the media. When you place your order with LT Scotland you will be asked to provide a contact e-mail address. Confirmation of the licence(s) you have purchased will be sent electronically to this e-mail address. When you purchase CD-ROMs you will be sent a letter advising you of the serial number required to use the software. Additional licences can be purchased as and when required.

Please note that it is the latest version of the software that will be shipped to you.

Acrobat Standard, Acrobat Professional, Creative Suite Premium, GoLive, Illustrator, InDesign, PageMaker, Photoshop & Premiere Elements, Photoshop, Photoshop Elements, Video Collection Standard and Video Collection Professional.

What you receive

When you place an order for Adobe products under this scheme you will be asked to supply an e-mail address for the licence confirmation to be sent to you electronically. If you have requested CD-ROMs, details of your serial number will be sent to you in a letter from LT Scotland.

Home purchasing

Home usage rights

No. Even if your school has purchased any of the products above you are not allowed to install the software on your home computer.
