

Clicker 4 Licence Scheme - Crick Software

What is the scheme?

LT Scotland has negotiated with Crick Software for Scottish schools to be able to purchase additional licences for Clicker 4 at a reduced price.

How does the scheme work?

To purchase under this scheme you must in the first instance have purchased the Single User licence for Clicker 4. This provided the media and licence documentation. Once this has been done, additional licences can be purchased at 30 per cent off the normal price.

What you receive

When you order additional licences for Clicker 4 software under this scheme you will receive a licence certificate. Please ensure you attach the licence stickers to the single user licence documentation in the spaces provided. This ensures that all of your Clicker 4 licences are kept together. This is your proof of purchase and acts as a licence confirmation. You may be required to produce this for audit purposes.

Home purchasing

No. Individual teachers cannot purchase Clicker 4 for home use under this scheme. A special home user product is available direct from Crick Software.

Home usage rights

Schools can purchase additional user licences to license teachers for using Clicker 4 at home. An additional licence will be required for each teacher who installs the software on their home machine to prepare schoolwork. These rights are for teachers and not for pupils. The scheme does not cover parents wishing to purchase Clicker 4 for home use.
