

Corel Transactional Licensing Scheme

What is the scheme?

LT Scotland is working with Corel to bring to education the Corel Transactional Licensing scheme. This scheme allows education to purchase products at a lower cost without the commitment of a contract.

How does the scheme work?

You can place an order for any quantity of licences, media and documentation as and when they are required. Please note that CD-ROMs and documentation will not be supplied in excess of licences purchased. Under this scheme maintenance is a two-year option available for purchase at the time the initial licence is purchased.

The following Corel products are available. Please note that it is the latest version of the software that will be shipped to you.

Corel Designer, Corel Draw Graphics Suite, Corel Ventura, iGrafx Flowcharter, iGrafx Process, WordPerfect Office and Corel XMetal, Corel Painter, Corel Smart Graphics Studio.

When you order

When you order products under the Corel Licensing Programme for Creative Applications you must remember to include the following details. These details must be provided to Corel in order for your order to be processed:

- product title
- the total number of licences and/or CD-ROMs and manuals required
- which platform – PC or Macintosh
- your order number
- full institution address, including postcode
- contact name
- telephone and fax numbers
- e-mail address.

Note: When you are ordering licences please ensure that you order the correct licences as it is not always possible for them to be exchanged.
