### What is the scheme?

Education institutions can purchase Macromedia's products under an education licensing scheme.

### How does the scheme work?

Education institutions initially purchase a licence and media and thereafter are able to purchase additional licences as and when required. Manuals are also available.

When you purchase licences and CD-ROMs for the first time, LT Scotland will provide you with a serial number that you must enter when you install the software. Please keep this serial number safe as you may need it again.

The licence you receive will be for the most up-to-date version available.
