Four sections of questions have been produced by Learning and Teaching Scotland for use by students studying Advanced Higher Chemistry. With three sections, the questions follow the sequence of topics within one of the units of the course. The fourth section, entitled Extra Questions, contains problems that have been kept aside for possible use in prelims or for end-of-course revision.

Most of the questions come from CSYS or Higher past papers. These questions carry a self-explanatory code at the end. Questions with no code have been newly written to cover both new topics and areas where questions seemed to be lacking. A few of these are designed to be useful learning exercises and do not fit the style of final exam questions.
