

## **Steps to Success in Managing Early Intervention**

### **Learning and Teaching Literacy**

#### **Children should be exposed to a culture of literacy by**

- Providing a variety of texts to foster a love of reading e.g. big books, class library, variety of genre
- Following a structured multi-sensory phonics programme to include pace and order of teaching sounds
- Creating opportunities for children to interact and communicate with others through literacy activities e.g. paired reading, rhyme time, storytelling etc
- Providing a variety of contexts to enrich the literacy programme e.g. games, enterprise, pupil council, structured play, Playground
- Offering opportunities for pupil interaction through listening and talking activities
- Identifying and providing opportunities to integrate ICT
- Promoting positive attitudes to literacy by valuing children's work e.g. star pupil awards, certificates, display of writing
- Aiming for more pupils to complete Level A by the end of P2
- Involving parents/carers in their child's learning
